Leadership & Governance

- Support the Board and membership to achieve the Club's purpose as defined in the constitution
- Participate as needed in strategy and planning at governance and operational level
- Help monitor the Club's annual calendar and budget in conjunction with the Board
- Participate in ensuring the Club policies and procedures are regularly reviewed and up to date
- Participate in ensuring the Club's Constitution aligns with SLSNZ requirements
- Promote governance and operational best practice within the Club

Board Responsibilities

- Attend Board meetings supporting equality, questioning, healthy discussion, quality decision making
- Provide expert advice and support, if needed, to key operational and governance roles
- Support & participate in Board Performance Review Process
- Support the Board in recruitment and appointment of operational roles

People Leadership & Culture

- Be a role model; engage, inspire, and support Club members and volunteers
- Promote good communication across the Club and between governance and operations
- Foster a culture of high standards, strong compliance and health & safety across all club functions

Stakeholder Engagement & Representation

- Manage key stakeholder relationships alongside the Board
- Represent the Club as a member of the Board if required.
